

Minutes of the proceedings of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Gueydan, Louisiana, taken at regular meeting held Tuesday, February 11, 2014, at 6:00 o'clock P.M.

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Gueydan, Louisiana met in regular session with Mayor David Dupuis presiding and the following Aldermen present:

Motion was made by GALE SMITH, seconded by CLAUDETTE PRICE, and carried, that in as much as each member of the Board of Aldermen received a copy of minutes taken at Regular Meeting of January 7, 2014, that the reading of said minutes be dispensed with and same be adopted as written.

Motion by CLAUDETTE PRICE, seconded by MARILYN CAMPBELL, and carried, that the reports of the Bookkeeper and Tax Collector be approved as filed.

Motion by GALE SMITH, seconded by CLAUDETTE PRICE, and carried that the following transfer, on the date, and amount from fund is hereby ratified and approved:

To General Fund:

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Billy Baker had requested to speak to the Governing Authority concerning Utility Bills. Mr. Baker was not at this meeting.

Bobby Broussard requested to speak to the Governing Authority concerning the Police Department. Mr. Broussard voiced his concerns about patrolling in the Simon Addition during the bus drop offs in the afternoons after school. No action was taken upon this matter, the Mayor informed Mr. Broussard he would address his concerns with the Police Chief.

Property Owners Responsibility for Utilities. The adopted Ordinance number 381, was read aloud to all present and said Ordinance which was adopted on April 5, 1988 which became effective on April 15, 1988 will remain as written. Motion by GALE SMITH, seconded by CLAUDETTE PRICE and carried that Ordinance number 381 will remain as written.

Councilman JUDE REESE arrived at 6:18 o'clock p.m.

Todd Vincent, Engineer with Sellers & Associates informed the Governing Authority that the Street Improvements Project is almost complete with dress up work and a patch needs to be done and said job would be complete.

An update on the USDA the application is being processed and a few more requests for information has been received which is going to be submitted shortly and that the terms of the loan are 20, 30 and 40 year terms. After a brief discussion the 30 year term to be paid out of sales tax account was looking to be the option to be considered. No action was taken at this time.

Fire Chief Evans Bourque was not at this meeting.

Police Chief Kayla Henry was not at this meeting.
