The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Gueydan, Louisiana met in regular session with Mayor Jude Reese presiding and the following Aldermen present:

Motion was made by JASON SUIRE, seconded by JOHN LASETER, and carried, that in as much as each member of the Board of Aldermen received a copy of minutes taken at Regular Meeting of July 5, 2022, and Special Meeting of July 12, 2022, that the reading of said minutes be dispensed with and same be adopted as written.

Motion by JASON SUIRE, seconded by JOHN LASETER, and carried, that the reports of the Bookkeeper and Tax Collector be approved as filed.

Motion by JOHN LASETER, seconded by JASON SUIRE, and carried that the following transfer, on the date, and amount from fund is hereby ratified and approved:

Motion by JASON SUIRE, seconded by JOHN LASETER and carried to approve the billing adjustments for the month of July 2022 in the amount of \$2,911.56.

Larry Cramer, engineer with Sellers & Associates presented Partial Payment #3 – Final payment to Glenn Lege Construction, LLC in the amount of \$44,447.82 to the governing authority. Mr. Cramer informed those in attendance a Request for Information from GOHSEP for the generator project and that the requested information has been sent. The project consists of generator for the Simon Addition and the Sewer Plant. Jason Suire suggested that a natural gas generator would be more convenient. Details will follow later. Mr. Cramer presented the quotes on the removal of the sludge at the sewer plant, the quotes were as follows: Glenn Lege Construction, Inc. \$72,965.00, E.B. Feutch & Sons, LLC \$22,500.00 and Southern Constructors, LLC \$81,215.81.

Public Hearing was held concerning the Golf Cart Ordinance, however, due to the technicality of Street Crossings needing approval from the Department of Transportation, the ordinance adoption was tabled.

Motion by JOHN LASETER seconded by SCOTT VALLO and carried to give the approval for collection of past due Ad Valorum Taxes.

Motion by JASON SUIRE, seconded by JOHN LASETER and carried to enter into a governmental agreement with the Town of Duson for the donation of two (2) police vehicles.

Police Chief Cru Delcambre recommended the acceptance of the resignation of Hollins Trahan, Jr. Motion by JASON SUIRE, seconded by JOHN LASETER and carried to accept the recommendation of Chief Delcambre to approve the resignation of Hollins Trahan, Jr as a patrolman with the Town of Gueydan.

Council member SCOTT VALLO announced his resignation effective August 2, 2022, at the end of the meeting.

There being no further business to come before the meeting thereupon motion by SCOTT VALLO, seconded by JOHN LASETER and carried the meeting thereupon adjourned at 6:16 o'clock P.M. on this 2<sup>ND</sup> day of August 2022.
