Mr. Larry Cramer, engineer with Sellers & Associates gave an update on the ongoing projects. The HMGP Drainage Pump Station Site Improvements, a preconstruction meeting was held on February 4, 2025 and a discussion was held on the construction schedule as well as Notice to Proceed which will be on or before March 17, 2025 and the project completed by October 3, 2025, also discussed the critical path of pump rehabilitation and suggested removing as soon as possible to be able to reinstall.

Mr. Cramer informed the governing authority that the LCDBG Clearance Program Application that the received Permission to Publish a combined Notice of No Significant Impact (FONSI) and Notice of Intent to Request Release of Funds (NOI/PROF) for the Environmental Review Record. This process takes a little more time as it has to be published in the paper for a certain number of days and allow for a comment period. Permission to advertise for bids should be sometime in April, 2025. The update on the LWI Round 2 Application all the field survey work is completed and now Sellers & Associates are compiling the drainage study for the application.

Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U)* on the first day of January, without the necessity of further action by the mayor and board of aldermen.

<u>SECTION II</u>: BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all reconnect fees, shut off fees or any other fees not specifically addressed this Ordinance per the Town of Gueydan Water Rates & Fees will stay at the same rate as presently established.
