Sellers & Associates monthly report was given to the mayor. The HMGP Drainage Pump Station Site Improvements: All punch list items have been completed and a resolution was prepared for the Acceptance and Notice of Acceptance which will be presented to the Vermilion Parish Police Jury. A resolution was also prepared for The Acceptance for the Town's concurrence with the recommendation of completion. The final partial payment #4 will be presented to the Police Jury in the amount of \$2,470.00. A request to pay the Town's portion of \$617.50.

LCDBG Clearance Program Application – contracts were sent to the Contractor on July 17, 2025, and should be returned to Sellers & Associates shortly for the Town to execute.

LWI Round 2 Application. The H & H model and application has been submitted. The application consists of cleaning and regarding ditches, enlargement and replacement of storm drainpipes, a second smaller pump for Simon Addition as well as an emergency generator.

## ORDINANCE NUMBER 2025-4

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SUB-CHAPTER 25B, SECTION 25:21 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF GUEYDAN, LOUISIANA, ENTITLED "WATER RATES" IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

<u>SECTION I</u>: BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF GUEYDAN, LOUISIANA, in regular session convened on this 7<sup>TH</sup> day of August 2025 that the provisions of Sub-Chapter 25B, Section 25:21 of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Gueydan entitled "Water Rates" is hereby amended to read as follows:

A. The monthly rate for the use of the Town of Gueydan's water system shall be charged to and collected in the amounts and from the classes and special users of the water system as follows:

- B. All residential customers who have reached the age of sixty-five (65) years shall receive a ten (10%) percent discount for monthly sewerage charges provided that their sewerage billing statement is paid by the fifteenth of the month said statement is rendered.
- C. These above rates shall be annually adjusted to the percent change from the previous 12 months using the most recent CPI as published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics, *Table 1. Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U)* on the first day of January, without the necessity of further action by the mayor and board of aldermen.

<u>SECTION II</u>: BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all reconnect fees, shut off fees or any other fees not specifically addressed this Ordinance per the Town of Gueydan Water Rates & Fees will stay at the same rate as presently established.

<u>SECTION III</u>: BE IT FURHER ORDAINED that if any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision, or part thereof, not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

<u>SECTION IV</u>: BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption and passage by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Gueydan, Louisiana.
