A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VERMILION PARISH POLICE JURY AND THE TOWN OF GUEYDAN TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT ALL IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF LA. R.S. 33:1321 ET. SEQ.

GENERAL STATEMENT OF CONTRACTUAL AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, the provisions of La. R. S. 33:1321 et seq, dealing with "intergovernmental functions", authorize the police jury of a parish and any city, town, or village, and any special district or political subdivision of the state to agree between and among themselves to engage jointly in the exercise of any power, and in the construction, acquisition or improvement of any public project or improvement, or the promotion and maintenance of any undertaking when either one of the participants in the agreement is authorized under provision of general or specific law to perform such activity or exercise such power as may be necessary for completion of the undertaking (La.R.S.33:1324); and

PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Police Jury and the Town of Gueydan wish to enter an agreement to perform routine maintenance projects for the period of January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2017. These projects include routine culvert installation, hauling of aggregate for drives and shoulders, patching

of roads, grading of shoulders and mowing of roadside ditches.

AGREEMENT

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town of Gueydan does:

RESOLVE THAT, they will provide some labor, equipment and the cost of materials as mutually agreed upon for each project, by the mayor and/or council; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Vermilion Parish Police Jury does;

RESOLVE THAT, to also provide labor, equipment and cost of some materials, subject to each project being reviewed by the respective Police Juror and parish supervisor.

RESOLVED FURTHER, by both parties, that a certified copy of this resolution shall immediately be filed and recorded in the records of the Clerk of Court for the Parish of Vermilion, Louisiana; and upon adoption of this resolution by both parties and recordation of same, it shall constitute the agreement between the Police Jury and the Town of Gueydan and a copy of this resolution shall be published in the official journal of the above said parties concerned.

ORDINANCE 2016-10

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES
OF THE TOWN OF GUEYDAN RELATIVE TO THE GAS
RATES

SECTION I: BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Gueydan, Louisiana, in regular session convened on this 6TH day of December, 2016, that the provisions of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Gueydan, entitled "Gas Rates" is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION II: IT IS HEREBY established that the gas rates to all customers of gas furnished by the Town of Gueydan be adjusted according to the following schedule:

A. RESIDENTIAL/COMMERCIAL CUSTOMERS

1. Applicability

This rate schedule is applicable for all private residences and individual family apartments and commercial establishments which are furnished gas by the Town of Gueydan, Louisiana. Gas will be supplied at one point of delivery, measured through one meter and shall not be shared or resold.

2. Monthly Rate

Eighty-five cents (0.85) per 100 cubic feet plus any adjustment in accordance with Section III for all gas purchased.

3. Minimum Monthly Charge

Four Dollars and Ten Cents (\$4.10) plus any adjustment.

B. INDUSTRIAL CUSTOMERS

1. Applicability

This rate schedule is applicable for all industrial customers which are furnished gas by the Town of Gueydan, Louisiana. The gas will be supplied at one point of delivery, measured through one meter and shall not be shared or resold.

2. Monthly Rate

Eighty-five cents (\$0.85) per hundred cubic feet plus any adjustment in accordance with Section III for all gas purchased.

3. Minimum Monthly Charge

Fifty-Five Dollars (\$55.00) plus any adjustment.

Section III: BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that any superseding rate adjustments for any natural gas purchased by the Town of Gueydan, whereby the cost of natural gas is less than or in excess of the base 1991 base average cost of \$2.15 per thousand cubic feet (mcf), the gas rates established in Section III may be adjusted for all customers of gas furnished by the Town of Gueydan at the same cost increase (decrease) per hundred cubic feet (ccf) as adjusted for the Town of Gueydan by the gas supplier, without formal change of this Ordinance by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Gueydan .

SECTION IV: BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption and passage by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Gueydan, Louisiana.

ORDINANCE NUMBER 2016-11

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SUB-CHAPTER E: SECTION 25:125 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF GUEYDAN, ENTITLED "ELECTRICITY RATES: IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Gueydan, Louisiana, to better serve their citizens and community, and as authorized by Louisiana Law, hereby establish the following electrical rates:

Section 2: Residence service (Schedule A).

(a) Electrical rates for residence service are as follows:

(1) Applicability. The rate applicable under the regular terms and conditions of the town for all domestic purposes in single-family residences or individual apartments.

(2) Rate.

Minimum Charge \$6.00 (Residential)
All kwh's at 4.6 cents per kwh.

(3) Power charge as per Section 4, shall be added to the above rate.

(b) The provisions of this section shall take effect and become applicable to all customers who meet the qualifications thereof, commencing upon adoption of this resolution.

Section 3: Commercial general service rate (Schedule B).

(a) There is hereby established an electrical rate for all commercial customers and all other customers who do not have eligibility for residence service as defined in Section 2 which rate shall be known as the commercial general service rate, Schedule B.

(1) Applicability. This rate is applicable to all users who's contract for electrical power for usages other than residential, as defined in Section 2, for the entire electrical requirements of such customers.

(2) Rate. Minimum charge \$10.00 (Commercial)
All kwh's at 7.0 cents per kwh

- (3) Power charge as per Section 4, shall be added to the above rate.
- (b) The provisions of this section shall take effect and become applicable to all customers who meet the qualifications thereof, commencing upon adoption of this resolution.

Section 4: Power Charge.

- (a) There is hereby established an electrical rate power charge, which shall be applicable equally to all electrical rates and to all electrical customers of the town which charge shall be added to the applicable rate to each customer in the amount equal to the total power cost plus 10% for system losses to the town of the charge for power from the Town's supplier based on the quantity of kwh sold to all electrical customers. The power charge cost/kwh shall be computed as follows:

$$\frac{\text{Total Supplier Bill (\$)}}{\text{Total kwh sold to customers}} = \text{kwh rate plus 10\%}$$

- (b) The power charge established shall take effect and become applicable to all electrical customers of the Town.
- (c) No electrical customer of the Town shall resell any electrical energy purchased from the Town, nor shall any customer supply electricity to any user, nor suffer any other user to take electricity from any electrical connection. The rules, regulations, and rates applicable to every electrical customer of the Town shall be considered a contract, and every person, by purchasing and using electricity from the Town shall be held to consent to and be bound thereby, and when any of the rules and regulations are violated, the Town shall be entitled to compensation for all losses and damages occasioned thereby, and may discontinue all electric service to the violate thereof.
- (d) It shall be unlawful for any person to violate or fail to comply with any provision of this Ordinance pertaining to the usage of electricity, and the violation of any provision thereof shall be punished in accordance with the Town code.

Section 5: Superseding rates.

Any effective superseding rate schedules from the Town's supplier of electricity to the Town may cause an adjustment of rates for all customers of electricity furnished by the Town at the same percentage increase or decrease as adjusted for the Town by its supplier rate shall apply without a formal change of this Ordinance by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen.

Section 6: All residential customers who have reached the age of sixty-five (65) years shall receive a ten (10%) per cent discount for monthly electrical charges if their utility billing statement is paid by the fifteenth of the month said statement is rendered.

Section 7: Effective Date.

The effective date of this Ordinance shall be when adopted by the Board of Aldermen. All Ordinances or Resolutions or parts thereof in conflict are herewith and hereby repealed. And this Ordinance being submitted to a vote, the vote thereon was as follows:

ORDINANCE NUMBER 2016-13

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SUB-CHAPTER 25C, SECTION 25:55 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF GUEYDAN, LOUISIANA, ENTITLED "SEWERAGE SYSTEM" IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:
