

Minutes of the proceedings of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Gueydan, Louisiana, taken at regular meeting held Tuesday, May2, 2017 at 6:00 o'clock P.M.

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Gueydan, Louisiana met in regular session with Mayor Chris Theriot presiding and the following Aldermen present:

Motion was made JASON SUIRE, seconded by CLAUDETTE PRICE, and carried, that in as much as each member of the Board of Aldermen received a copy of minutes taken at Regular Meeting of April 4, 2017, that the reading of said minutes be dispensed with and same be adopted as written.

Motion by GALE SMITH, seconded by JASON SUIRE, and carried, that the reports of the Bookkeeper and Tax Collector be approved as filed.

Motion by JASON SUIRE, seconded by CLAUDETTE PRICE to introduce an ordinance "AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AND ORDERING THE MILLAGE RATE TO BE LEVIED AGAINST THE PROPERTY IN THE TOWN OF GUEYDAN, LOUISIANA, AND SPECIFYING THE AMOUNT OF TAXES TO BE ASSESSED AND COLLECTED AGAINST EACH DOLLAR OF ASSESSMENT VALUATION OF SAID TOWN." A public hearing will be held on June 6, 2017, at 5:50 P.M. and vote for final adoption will be held at the regular meeting of June 6, 2017, which meeting begins at 6:00 P.M.

Motion by JASON SUIRE, seconded by CLAUDETTE PRICE and carried for approval of a liquor license to be issued to DG Louisiana, Inc., D/B/A Dollar General Store #4951.

Fire Chief Evans Bourque presented a current listing of Volunteer Firemen to the governing authority.

Mayor Chris Theriot talked about the drainage issues which a project is ongoing to alleviate the problems.
