The following Ordinance was introduced by JASON SUIRE, seconded by GALE SMITH:

ORDINANCE NUMBER 2018-1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE I, SEC. 2-3 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF GUEYDAN, LOUISIANA, ENTITLED “COMPENSATION OF OFFICERS”.

SECTION 1: BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF GUEYDAN, LOUISIANA, in regular session convened on this 6th day of February, 2018, provisions of Chapter 2, Article I, Sec 2-3 of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Gueydan entitled “Compensation of Officers” is hereby amended to read as follows:

The compensation to be received by the municipal officers of the town is hereby fixed as follows:

- Mayor, per month \$1,400.00
- Aldermen, per month \$ 250.00

(If more than one special call meeting of the Board of Aldermen is held during any month, Aldermen are to receive an additional \$15.00 per meeting for each meeting held thereafter during that month. No additional compensation shall be paid for the first special call meeting held per month.)

- Chief of police, per month \$ 2,500.00
- (4) City Clerk \$ 663.00
- (5) Clerk of Mayor’s Court \$ 306.00

SECTION 2: All ordinances and resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall become effective January 1, 2019.

SECTION 4: BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, ETC., that any part of this Ordinance or Amendment thereto which shall be held in invalid or unconstitutional by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect the validity or impair any part of this Ordinance .

This Ordinance having been considered section by section and submitted to a vote upon the whole, the vote thereon resulted as follows:
